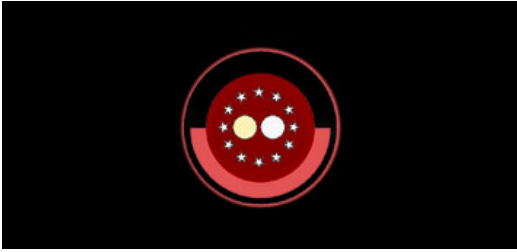


Epistle: "Bind"
