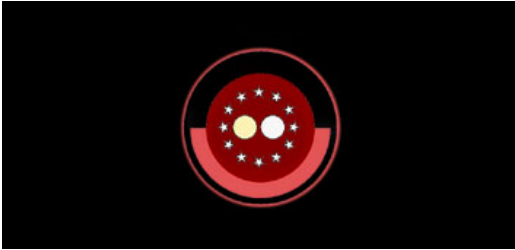


Epistle: Exhault/Exhort

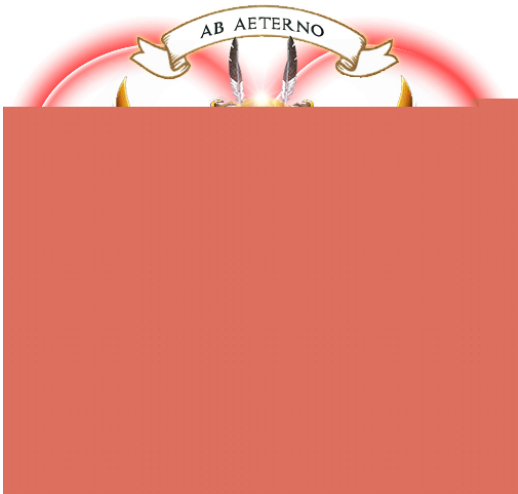
