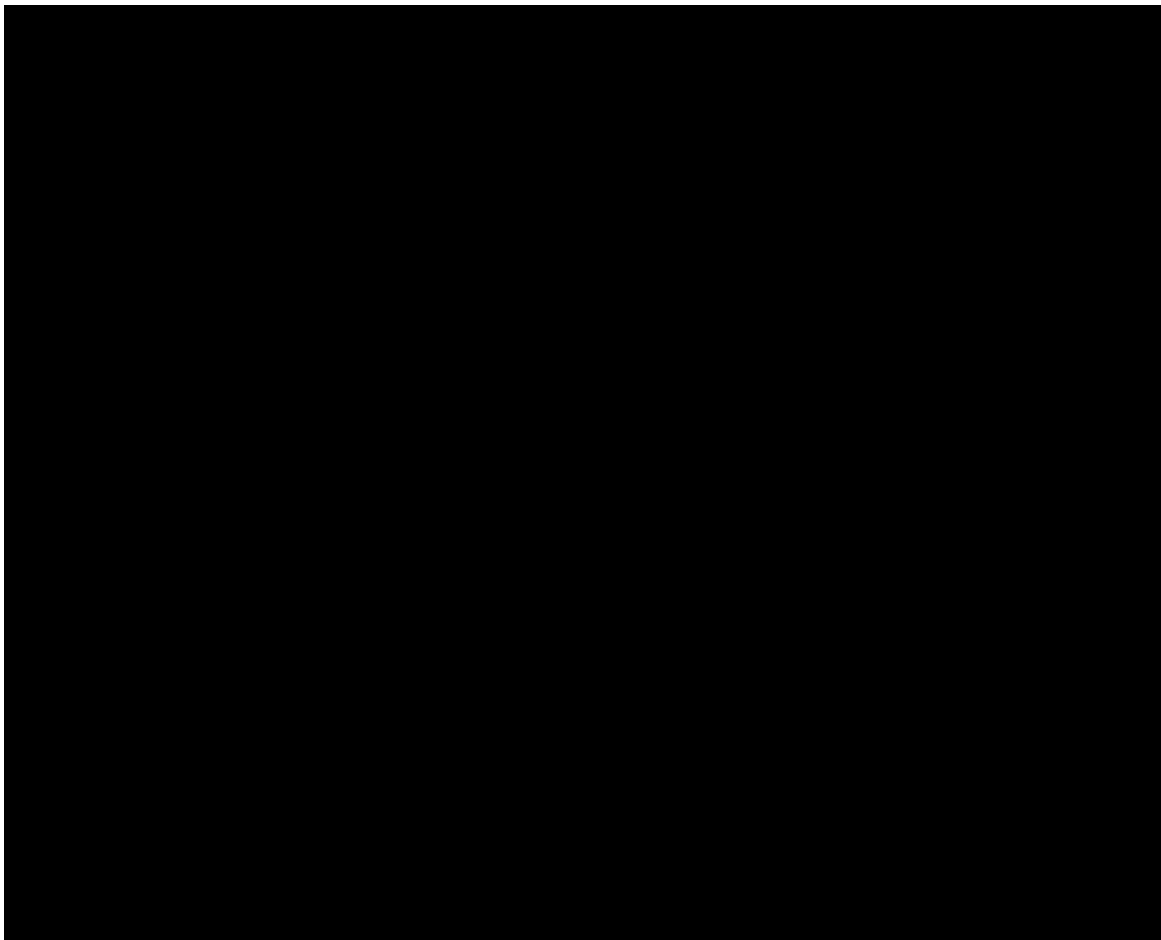


Epistle Concerning the "Hast"
