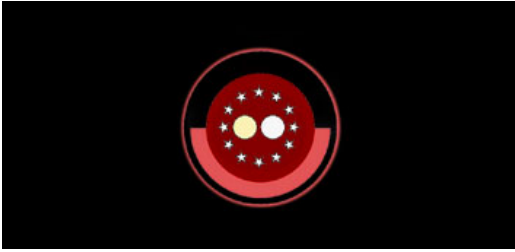


Epistle: "Hungry"
